Montessori Farm School Enrollment Process

Choosing a school for your child is an important decision. The following information explains the steps within our enrollment process and gives you a timeline. Please ask any and all questions you may have.

1. Contact our school to set up a time to visit. This meeting is for parents/guardians to learn more about our school with a tour of our space and chat with our lead teacher/head of school. Please allow approximately 45 minutes for your visit.

2. After observing, we will send you a link to our application. These are completed online through Brightwheel and it will require you to set up an account.. There is a \$75 non-refundable application fee due when you submit your application.

3. When considering applications we must take into account the balance of our classroom regarding ages and learning styles. Priority is given to returning students, siblings, and students transferring from Montessori schools. Kindergarten spaces are usually filled by rising 5 year olds from the current class. When considering adding a new kindergarten age student, if there is space, we would arrange a visit with the student prior to making a decision.*

4. If your family is offered a space in our classroom, you will be sent an online link with instructions for completing enrollment. This link will be active for ten days, and during that time we welcome any additional questions you may have.

Admissions Timeline for the 2025-26 School Year

November 18th- Online applications go live for new families. You will be sent a link automatically if you have already visited.

January 6th- Re-enrollment begins for returning families First round of of acceptances offered to rising 3 year olds from application pool

January 31st-Second round of acceptances for new students from waiting pool

February 28th- Third round of acceptances for new students from waiting pool

After February 28th Applications will be considered as they are received if spaces remain*

*The Montessori classroom is designed to be a three year cycle with third year students (kindergarten) acting as the leaders and mentors of the community. These students are building on a mastering skills that they have worked on in the two years prior and it is not always suitable to enroll for a single year of Montessori unless they are planning for Montessori for lower elementary as well.
